**Connor Sport Court International Partners With
U.S. Soccer Foundation to Provide Free Real tickets
To Sorenson Multi-Cultural Center Kids**

Salt Lake City, Utah—A lot of Salt Lake City children will be attending Salt Lake Real Soccer Games free this year as a result of a contribution of season tickets by Connor Sport Court International and the U.S. Soccer Foundation.

Sorenson Multi-Cultural Center, 855 California Avenue, was presented with 20 season tickets as part of an outreach program sponsored by Sport Court® and the U.S. Soccer Foundation.

Futsal is extremely popular in South America and is often cited as the source of the creative and skillful style demonstrated by soccer players from South American countries such as Brazil.
