Omaha, Nebraska—The National Collegiate Athletic Association’s Division I Women’s Volleyball championships will be played at the Omaha Qwest Center Dec. 18 and 20 on official surfaces provided by Connor Sport Court International.

Sport Court® volleyball surfaces will also be installed at each regional site; Penn State University, Colorado State University, the University of Texas and the University of Washington from December 11-14.

Hosts for the championships will be the University of Nebraska, Lincoln, and the Nebraska Sports Commission.

Sport Court will provide about 35,000 total square feet of its Response™ high-performance flooring, for the championship at the Qwest Center and the regional locations.
